Ramona Humane Society (RHS) will determine the criteria for fostering, decide which animals will be fostered, and appoint foster care providers from the approved list. Approved foster care providers may always refuse any specific request for whatever reason. RHS will inform you of any medical treatments to be given, the expected length of foster care needed, the objectives of the care (restoring to health, rearing to adoptable age, etc.) and any other expectations relevant. As a foster care provider, you are expected to keep the animal secure, be willing to return it to the RHS when requested, and not promise the animal to anyone. Adoptions can only be arranged through the RHS. You must be able to cope with returning the animal regardless of outcome and the possibility that an animal you have fostered may be euthanized at a later date.
